The Brunnenmarkt is the longest street market in Europe with people from all over the world. In *StoryTelling:Europe!* stories and perspectives on a peaceful, diverse future Europe are collected.

StoryTelling:Europe! focuses on the encounters between participants who previously had no relationship with each other. Kids and neighbors come together. In a playful dialogue, the project opens up an invisible but tangible space for listening and telling stories about experiences in contemporary Europe, as well as questioning and imagining a common future. The children ask questions, and through their presence and imagination they give the neighbors a special opportunity to tell their stories.

The artists Melika Ramić and Livia Heisz visited shopkeepers and workers at Brunnenmarkt with the children of Gaullachergasse elementary school. In small groups they explored stores and market stalls and now present their experiences and stories to the public in the form of StoryWalks.


Through an interactive walk, the project's protagonists take us on a sensory journey that allows us to question our notions of culture and shows us multiple windows into diverse life experiences: At Aria Supermarket, we are told about individual futures in Europe; at Garbanzo, we travel through personal memories to Bucharest, London and Vienna; further, at Blumen Weiser, we dive into a story about watering plants; and finally, at DiliES, we enter the world of sweets. In the restaurant Kent, we find out what the many photos on the wall are all about.


